Ever wanted to get away and just paint? Tackle different projects, learn new techniques, experiment with them and be able to show some results from your efforts? Get a little outside your box? This is the opportunity for you and your art!

Our guest artist, instructor and guide will be Jacqueline Anderson, a board member of the RRWS and famed teacher. Jacqueline is a graduate of Minnesota State University Moorhead. She is a retired Fargo Public Schools' Art teacher with 27 years of teaching Art at Ben Franklin Jr. High and North High School. She is currently employed as a Supervisor of Student Teachers for MSUM and works at special events for Talent Productions of Fargo, as a caricature artist.

Jackie has taught, taken lessons, and painted around the Upper Midwest, Europe, and Scandinavia and enjoys sharing what she learns with others. She is an ardent supporter of new artists and is delighted to have an opportunity to offer a workshop for RRWS members and friends with a focus on learning and developing skills in a non-threatening, fun, creative and productive manner.

The weekend is broken into three mini-workshops with time for painting en plein aire, in the woods or around the Retreat Centre or taking in the Art Leap – a studio crawl for local artists and an annual highlight around Park Rapids.



We are going to paint "out of the box" by changing a "realistic composition" into a "semi- abstract", stressing composition and art fundamentals. All the pieces will be no bigger than a quarter sheet or smaller so no lugging large pieces of equipment. The equipment list will be just the necessities and we will strive to use them in different and challenging ways.

Northern Pines is a beautiful 90 mile drive from Fargo. Situated on the Fish Hook Lake, it provides a quiet sanctuary of pleasant scenery and sights. The fall colors should be raging the weekend of September 24 2009, as we head out for 2 nights and 3 days of painting pleasure.

Accommodation is shared in rustic cabins and is limited this year. Bring your own bedding. For those wanting to visit local hotels or B&B's and not stay at Northern Pines, you can participate in our workshop and enjoy meals with us – a new pricing option is being offered this year.

Most meals are provided – Friday night, bring a bag supper to enjoy before our first workshop session begins. Hiking, eagle watching, walks, boating, and lovely scenery will be ours to enjoy – when we are not enjoying the vitality and creativity of Jackie!

An option is to come out earlier on Friday afternoon and join one of our 3 esteemed artists for a 2 hour workshop on a specific topic.

Sandy Miles is an active charter member of RRWS, teacher, mentor, educator, speaker and well-known artist in the Fargo area. She has won awards in national and local shows, exhibits widely and is a YMCA Woman of the Year for her avid support and promotion of art and artists in the community. She will share a technical fun workshop on adding negative painting techniques using natural objects to create more visual interest in your art, and producing more values. This practical application of paint and science teaches all skill levels the powers of the technique.

Judi Koehmstedt, Fargo, has been drawing and painting most of her life. Always being aware of the beauty and humor in human behavior, she incorporates that into her work and will present a workshop on painting hands. Judi has exhibited in many regional juried shows. Judi has attended most of the workshops offered by the RRWS, learning techniques from important artists from around America. She is an ardent student and has shared her workshop on painting faces to much acclaim in our community.



Donna Chalimonczyk, Moorhead, began painting in 1998 when I joined the Cormorant Area Art Club as a charter member. Since then have dedicated much of my time to learning about the art of painting and learning from nationally recognized artists at area workshops. The artists I have met through the lake art club, The Hjemkomst Artist Studio, Red River Watercolor Society and the FM Visual Artists have been extremely helpful and supportive as I go along this creative path. With local materials available all around us, we will construct a semi-abstract painting using your harmonious palette. We discuss

composition, color arrangement and paint texturing to achieve a woodland carpet resembling our retreat surroundings.

The cost of the workshop is an additional \$20 and they will run from 3:00pm to 5:00pm. You can only pick 1 and the class size is limited to 5 people each. Classes will be allocated on a first paid basis. Please indicate which workshop you would prefer on your registration form. If we have overwhelming demand, we may offer them again possibly on the Saturday or Sunday afternoon, depending on artist availability and schedules. Make a note on your registration form so we can judge demand.

We are excited to be able to offer this opportunity for other RRWS members to showcase their talents and for our weekend attendees to have an opportunity to learn a little something different.
